# Leisure Time

Do you need some time to relax? Come visit one of the Webster City's numerous parks and recreational facilities. We have so much to offer, you will definitely have to come and see for yourself with family, friends and neighbors.

## **Fuller Hall Recreation Center** (625 Bank Street)

This full service center offers a 25 meter swimming pool, newly remodeled weight room, cardio-vascular fitness room, game room, television lounge, multi-purpose gym, racquetball courts, locker rooms, and conference room. Examples of recreation programs offered include: indoor park for parents and preschoolers, youth basketball, volleyball, flag football, track programs, tae kwon do, aerobic classes, aquacise classes, and swimming lessons. Building rental or partial facility rental is also available.



## Parks

### **Brewer Creek Park** (1801 Des Moines Street)

Open year round with sledding in the winter. A shelter is available for party rentals. Brewer Creek also offers a two mile recreational trail and wildlife refuge.

### **Kendall Young Park** (600 Kendall Young Road)

This park is a beautiful rustic park that has four shelter houses, six picnic areas, 2 shuffleboard courts, horseshoe pits, a mountain bike course through the woods, playground equipment, and a fishing area.

### **Twin Parks** (1000 Superior Street)

West Twin Parks offers a shelter house and a band shell, wonderful playground equipment, and beautiful green space. East Twin Parks offers a skate park, a basketball court, four tennis courts, and a playground area.



### **Nokomis Park/ Middleton Sports Complex**

(700 East Street)

This complex offers a picnic area, two softball fields, ice skating rink, and Boone River Trail Head parking.

## Boone River Recreational Trail

This 5.7-mile multipurpose trail winds along the scenic Boone River, providing visitors a view of natural prairies, farmland, timber, and an abundance of wildlife. The north trailhead is located in Nokomis Park and the south end of the trail is at Briggs Woods County Park. This handicap accessible trail offers fishing jetties, rest areas, picnic and recreational opportunities along the entire route. It connects two golf courses, one county park, two campgrounds, three city parks, and one private park.

## Swimming Pool

Come enjoy our beautiful outdoor pool. Our facility includes a bathhouse, zero-depth entrance ramp for handicap accessibility, 25 meter lap lanes, diving well complete with low and high diving boards, and 180-foot water slide.

## Golfing

Enjoy a great day or weekend of golfing at our three wonderful golf courses. Webster City Links Golf Course is an 18-hole course within the city limits that is sure to entice your golfing spirit. Briggs Woods Golf Course is dubbed one of the most challenging courses in the State of Iowa and is located just a few miles south of Webster City. Dougusta Par 3 Golf Course is a great nine hole course that is small enough to enjoy a round of golf and still have time to enjoy most of your morning or afternoon doing something else.

## Cross Country Skiing

Webster City has recently purchased a cross-country ski trail groomer to start grooming some wonderful trails for cross-country skiing. Whether you are a pro or just starting out, Webster City is a great place to cross-country ski. Rental skies are available through Hamilton County Conservation.
